The Grantsburg Village Board of Trustees meets the second Monday of each month at 6:00 p.m. at 316 S. Brad Street. All meetings are open to the public. If you would like to appear at a meeting, please call the Village office at 715/463-2405, by the Thursday prior to the meeting, to be placed on the agenda.



In an emergency it is important that police, fire and ambulance services can easily locate your home. Street numbers must be affixed to all homes in the Village. The numbers must be no less than 2 1/2 inches high on a background of not less than three inches. Please make sure your house complies with these guidelines as described in the ordinance, §464-16 Street Numbers. ### **Hydrant Flushing**

Public Works personnel will be releasing water from hydrants in October. Hydrant flushing is necessary to test the hydrants to make sure adequate flow and pressure is available and to remove sediment from the pipes. Occasionally, water becomes discolored after hydrant flushing. If this happens, run your cold water tap for a few minutes until the water runs clear. If it doesn't clear the first time, wait a few minutes and run the water again. You should avoid washing clothes until the water clears.

### **Brush & Leaf Site**

To access the Village Brush Site, please visit the Village Office for a key Monday - Friday 8am - 4:30pm. The key must be returned the same day that you check it out. You may also gain access on Saturdays when the recycling center is open.

### **Leaves**

Please do not place leaves in the curb or street. Rather, compost leaves on site or dispose of them at the Village brush site. Please empty the leaves from the garbage bags when dumping at the brush site. We appreciate your help!
