FALL HYDRANT FLUSHING



The Public Works Crew will be flushing fire hydrants this fall. Hydrant flushing is necessary to make sure adequate flow and pressure is available and also to remove sediment from the pipes. Occasionally, water becomes discolored after hydrant flushing. If this happens, run your cold water tap for a few minutes until the water runs clear. If it doesn't clear the first time, wait a few minutes and run the water again. You should avoid washing clothes until the water clears.
